Burton Book Fund 2015-16 General Information & Student Application

INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on making the important decision to continue your studies and to achieve your higher education goals. The road ahead may not always be an easy one but it will be one that you can definitely achieve!

The Burton Book Fund was created to help students pay for textbooks. We know that books are expensive and we understand that you have many other expenses to pay for to stay in school.

LEVEL OF ASSISTANCE

The amount that will be available to you to help you pay for your textbooks will depend on the number of units in which you are enrolled. The box below indicates the level of funding available to you to help pay for textbooks.

- Students who are enrolled for 9 or more units in the Fall term will receive up to \$350 in textbook fund support.
- Students who are enrolled for 6-8 units in the Fall term will receive up to \$200 in textbook fund support.
- Students who are enrolled for less than 6 units in the Fall term will receive up to \$100 in textbook fund support.

ELIGIBILITY

This year, eligible students for the Burton Book Fund are defined as students are enrolled in a post-secondary institution **and who were in foster care on or after age 13.**
