Honors Institute* participants can enjoy the additional benefits of being an Honors Scholar. These benefits include receiving a special transcript notation, transfer admission preference (UCLA, Mills, others), and additional scholarship opportunities (based upon funding availability). * Note: Students must be admitted Honors Institute participants to apply for the Honors Scholar designation.

Instructions.

1. Complete at least 7 required honors courses as outlined below with the minimum 3.3 cumulative GPA.
2. Submit a completed Honors Scholar form to the Honors Institute. Contact the Honors Institute for information regarding deadlines.

Complete a minimum of five courses from Section I. Note: A maximum of two courses may be completed for Honors Scholar credit from section IB (Approved Alternate Courses).

UCLA TRANSFER ADMISSION PROGRAM (TAP) Requirements

To be eligible for the UCLA TAP program, students must also complete the honors scholar requirements. **NOTE: Students must complete at least 11.5 honors units by the end of the fall quarter preceding their transfer in order to be eligible for UCLA TAP Certification.** TAP applicants must be regular participants in the Foothill Honors Institute in order to receive these benefits. UCLA TAP applicants should see a Foothill counselor early for appropriate course planning. Appointments are available either by phone at 650.949.7423 or online at http://foothillglobalaccess.org/main/advising_center.htm Unless there are mitigating reasons why students are unable to complete their courses at Foothill College (e.g. because lower division major preparation courses are unavailable at Foothill), UCLA TAP applicants must complete all courses at Foothill College while they are participating in the Honors program.
