- 1. Minutes from the January 27 meeting were approved.
- 2. Proposals: Lori Bertani will be handing in her proposal. Eric Reed requested \$748 for four Math My Way textbooks. Victor motioned, Voltaire seconded. Approved.
- 3. Victor, Teresa, Justin and Maureen attended the Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI) workshop in Oakland on February 22. Four strategies to increase student completion of transfer-level courses in English and math were presented:
- Using multiple measures in student assessments.

- Corequisite Remediation giving students extra concurrent support to reduce their chances of dropping out.
- Math and English acceleration courses.
- Contextualized Instruction.
- Integrating Instruction with Student Services
- 5. California Community Colleges (CCC) is sponsoring a \$1.5 million grant over 3 years to assist community colleges in getting students from basic skills courses into college level pathways. A proposal was sent to Foothill's President's Cabinet for their review. If approved, the Basic Skills sub committee will complete the grant application by the deadline of March 25. The proposal's primary components are hiring a Basic Skills Coordinator and 2 Basic Skills Counselors. The sub committee will meet every Monday starting February 29.
- 5. Elaine Kuo's presentation was tabled until the May 2016 meeting.
