Accreditation Meeting

Standard IIC: Student Learning Programs: Library and Learning Support Services

May 17, 2010

Discussion:

The meeting covered Standard 2 .C.1.b : Institution provides ongoing instruction for users of library and other learning support services so that students are able to develop skills in information competency.

Committee members reviewed the evidence listed for the standard. The committee members agreed that the majority of listed evidence for this standard relates to library instruction. [In a separate review of the evidence by the library members, it was determined that most of the evidence listed is available, with the exception of the "Library Instructional Services Annual Plan."]

The Tutorial Center submitted a write up for the standard.

- There was a discussion of Soc Sci 75: Tutor Training Methods. This course will be included in the description of the tutorial Center, but currently there are no student learning outcomes or way to measure or asses this course.
- Mary will be developing SLO's for Lib 71 and offered to help create SLO's for SocSci 75.

The Media Center has no specific courses, but will work on a description to be included in the program description.

The library has three courses, LIBR 1: Principles of Library Research, LIBR 50: Introduction to Library Skills, and LIBR 71: Research Paper Search Strategies. LIBR 1 and 50 have been deactivated and need to be reviewed. The strength of the library instruction program is now in the research course. Evidence for assessing this course can be found in course statistics and library surveys.

There was a discussion of library instruction within the Counseling 50 classes. Assessment of this instruction is included in the instruction librarian's review of these sessions.

It was decided by the committee to meet every week in order to cover all the standards by the end of the quarter. Some meetings will be held on Wednesdays instead of Mondays. Proposed meeting dates: Monday, May 24, Wednesday, June 2, Wednesday, June 9, and Wednesday, June 16. Meetings will be held at 2 pm. Linda will schedule these meetings on Meeting Maker. The timeline for the self student was verified per the April 12 Standard II Committee Meeting
