- February 9 SIP groups receive Ed Master Plan Goals Template for use in completing Strategic Initiative goals
- February 23 SIP groups hold second meeting to discuss EMP Goals Template
- February 26 Accreditation Kickoff

- March 3 PaRC meets – Approve final draft of Governance Handbook
- March 5 ACCJC Accreditation Training
- March 10 SIP groups complete Goals Template for inclusion in Ed Master Plan
- March 12 Divisions and areas submit completed Resource Requests to SIP groups
- March 12 Institutional Learning Outcomes Convocation
- March 16 SIP groups joint meeting for 1st hour; training on prioritization process and considerations
- March 16 - April 30 SIP groups complete prioritizations; OPC reviews requests in light of existing funding protocols, restrictions, & requirements; OPC identifies available funding

- April 7 PaRC discusses first draft of Ed Master Plan, send to SIP groups and participatory governance groups
- April 16 PaRC receives feedback on first draft of Ed Master Plan from participatory groups
- April 21 PaRC discusses first draft of Ed Master Plan and feedback/Reviews Perkins funding recommendations
- April 30 PaRC receives second draft of EMP and completed prioritization of requests to from SIP Groups; OPC shares funding availability advisory information

- May 5 PaRC and OPC joint meeting; discuss/approves second Draft of EMP, PaRC reviews full list of priorities from SIP groups; opportunity to ask questions on process or funding options; Round 1 priority rankings follow mtg (due Friday May 14)
- May 19 PaRC discussion of Round 1 priority rankings; Round 2 priority rankings follow mtg (due Friday May 28)

- June 2 PaRC discussion of Round 2 priority rankings; final recommendations to President
- June 16 President shares resource allocation plan following review of PaRC recommendations
