Agenda Item 2: Action Items

Objective 1: Summer Bridge Program- for Math

- i. Will reach 3 Levels
 - ALD
 - MMW
 - Elementary Alg. 220
- ii. Students will be found by the following parameters, according to Elaine Kuo (total of 312 found thus far using the parameters below)
 - Students who were first time at Foothill
 - Age under 25 years
 - Interested in transfer
 - Seeking degree
 - Haven't taken the testing
- ii. Contact these students: (Lyliana Outreach)
 - 1. Email and addresses
- iii. Who will do the marketing?
 - 1. Purpose: if you are trying to finish your math requirement, a degree or transfer
 - 2. Lyliana
 - 3. Outreach- ask about possibility for Day on the Hill

- a.Contact Alex Duran?
- 4. Teresa will talk to Denise Swett and see how we might be able to reach students who will be recruited for Day on the Hill
- Looking to serve 120 students total: How can we increase the parameters?
 - o Have students self-select based upon specific questions- such as:
 - If you took Algebra 2 in HS but haven't taken math in a couple of years
 - o Include search for athletes (recruit from Kinesiology)
 - Tap into students who are attending Day on the Hill (get names from Outreach)
- Possible dates for summer bridge programs:
 - Is it possible to start recruitment efforts at least 2 weeks before fall registration (July 19)?
 - Is it possible to offer classes in mid-quarter (spring) bridge programs so as to capture recent high school graduates during the Foothill school year? (start in mid June, for example)
 - If so, how can we register them in banner as a "special group" to enroll them at the end of the class?
 - Can we flag them in banner and designate them to track their enrollment? Can we create a cohort?
 - Voltaire says possible- code students and then give them priority registration
 - Registration (after bridge programs):
 - How will we guide their registration?
 - Can we force them to meet with a counselor after the bridge program ends to make sure they register?
 - In the past students were asked to register as a group on the last day of bridge program
 - Enrolled in CNSL 50 and NCBS and would be able to register for fall quarter (at end of bridge program)
 - Outreach:
 - Application data from spring?
 - Print up flyers, cards to reach out to high school students?
 - Possible to have outreach go to high schools at the end of the high school year?
 - Voltaire: talk to high school counselors about when might be a good time to recruit- possibly contact high school math teachers
 - Voltaire will need numbers from Elaine on how many recent high school students applied to Foothill
 - Can we ask Kathleen Turner to help promote when she goes out to HS? We can get placement scores from those students and have Turner insert text that lets students know they qualify for the bridge programs?
- I. Objective 2: IRW-
 - Update:

- PGA course: we will begin meeting to plan the English 242a/b Portfolio Course
- Begin sharing information to divisions to distribute information to students on curriculum sheets
 - IRW group will meet with curriculum so that curriculum reps can report back to divisions

Agenda Item 3: KHAN Academy Presentation: Peter Murray

- What it is:
 - o Videos: organized by subject and specific concepts within subjects
 - Vignettes: mini-lessons
 - Students can monitor their progress with reward system by moving through a taxonomy
 - Allows connection to Gmail in order to create cohorts and provides teachers an opportunity to monitor student progress
- Use of KHAN Academy and other YouTube Videos
 - o Math My Way
 - o Chemistry and Physics courses- to help students with the math
- PSME has submitted a grant:
 - o CISP Grant through MIT and Harvard
 - Integration of videos and other such sites into classes
