- Necessary due to retirements.
- FT retirements and 1 FT resignation, would make FT/PT ratio very low

PSME: Physics

- Increasing enrollment (not as much as Accounting; similar to Business), FT/PT ratio is low, but not as low as Accounting
- Substantial growth as physics is identified in multiple ADT degrees; highly technical area with difficulty in finding adjunct faculty; need FT faculty to sustain and grow program.
