#### **Section Rating**

Each of the critical sections (Trend Analysis, Equity-Institutional Standards, Core Missions, Outcomes Assessment, Outcomes Reflection, and Program Goals) will be analyzed and evaluated based on the following criteria.

## A) Green:

- a. Response is clear and addresses the question, AND
- b. Results document improvements in program practices, AND
- c. Any trends in the data are steady or increasing.

#### B) Yellow:

a. Response is incomplete or unclear.

OR

b. Issues are identified along with ideas for improvement.

OR

c. Trends show a decline.

### C) Red:

a. Response is missing.

OR

b. Response identifies issues but does not demonstrate a viable plan for improvement.

OR

c. Trends show an abrupt change or persistent decline.

# Overall Rating (from the Program Review Committee Charter)

- Green signifies the program is recommended to continue in the regular program review cycle.
- Yellow signifies that trend analysis indicates the program is not meeting targets and/or indicators identified within the program review document, or that the program review document is incomplete.
- Red signifies that trend analysis indicates a notable and persistent decline in viability, an abrupt change to one or more of the targets and/or indicators, or that a program previously categorized as yellow has not successfully implemented its remediation plan.
