❖ Grade Options for Courses: Faculty have three options for credit course grade types: Letter Grade Only, Letter Grade with a Pass/No Pass Option (student may select) and Pass/No Pass Only. Be aware that grade options may have negative affects for some students. Some 4-year institutions will not accept major courses with a "Pass" grade, others will take a "Pass" but give the student grade points as though it is a "C" grade. Please speak with a Counselor or the Articulation Officer if you're unclear about your course's transfer significance.
