- ❖ State Approval Received: We have finally received state approval for an AS degree and three Certificates of Achievement in *Geographic Information Systems Technology*, that our curriculum committee approved June 2014. Congratulations to Allison Lenkeit Meezan and the Business and Social Science Division.
- New Departments/Subject Areas: In order to best assist the students by clarifying instructional "threads", there will be two new departments for 2016-17:
