- ❖ C-ID & ADT Update: Foothill currently has 161 C-ID approved courses, 11 conditionally approved, 10 denied, and 24 still in the queue. The state chancellor's office is continuing to create templates for more ADTs and as of June 30th, every submitted core course for the ADTs must have C-ID approval.
- Curriculum System Evaluation: The subcommittee evaluation process included the following: participation in two outside vendor demos, review of the De Anza home-built system, review of the feedback from faculty and consideration of the upcoming change in personnel in the Instruction Office. The subcommittee prioritized identified needs for the system, and have suggested that we work on making four high-priority modifications to the current system by the end of Fall quarter. The subcommittee, with feedback from the faculty, will evaluate the success of the changes and determine if we should continue with efforts to upgrade C3MS or continue researching outside vendor software.

## REMINDERS:

- ❖ CCC Division Reps: Want to make a difference? Here's your opportunity to participate on College Curriculum Committee! There are multiple divisions that need new reps for the 2015-16 year. Ask your current rep for more information.
- ❖ SLOs on CORS: Confused already? Just in case you haven't heard, we are required to have our Student learning Outcome statements (SLOs) appear on our Course Outlines of Record (CORs). Faculty will continue to write, reflect and assess in TracDat and programming in the background will move the (SLO) statements into the CORs. This will not trigger outlines to go through the approval process again, nor will C3MS allow for direct changes to the SLOs. All changes/adjustments must be made in TracDat.

## "WE NEED YOUR FEEDBACK!" ITEMS:

❖ ADT Reciprocity: Now that we have 20 ADTs approved at our institution, how do these affect our students that have credit from other CCCs? As with all new legislation, the rules are lengthy but have some leeway for FH to establish how we will handle course reciprocity. Please review the draft presented at CCC on June 2nd (available through your CCC rep) and provide feedback so we may establish the best policy for students.
