- ❖ **AP Credit Policy:** The Articulation Office recently completed extensive research to determine how CSUs/UCs grant AP credit. Divisions have received information regarding each AP exam relevant to their division, including how credit is granted for each CSU and UC. Divisions have been asked to revisit Foothill's current policy for each relevant AP exam, while taking CSU/UC system-wide information into consideration. Please note the proposed policy revision suggested by the Articulation Office. Divisions will bring feedback and/or proposed policy changes back to CCC for group discussion, later this spring quarter.
