- ❖ **Early College Promise & Law Pathway Programs:** Information was shared with CCC regarding two exciting new partnerships between Foothill and local high schools:

Early College Promise is a dual enrollment program, focused mainly on AVID students, which provides the opportunity for them to take Foothill courses for free (including fees and required textbooks). Please refer to the [Early College Promise](#) website for more information, and contact Nazy Galoyan with any questions.

Foothill is participating in the Law Pathway program, a partnership between 28 California community colleges and six law schools, intended to help diversify the law profession and support underrepresented students. The program infuses dual enrollment, allowing students to take all or some Foothill courses (from a specific list) during high school.
