

## Foothill College Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

From Spring 2015 and Spring 2016:

- Enrollment
  - Resident and non-resident estimated WSCH is up 1% at 143,121.
  - Total headcount is up 3% at 12,434.
  - Resident estimated WSCH is up 2% at 117,883.
  - Non-resident estimated WSCH is down 3% at 25,238.

- Online Learning
  - Total online learning estimated WSCH is up 3% at 47,206.
  - Online learning headcount is up 5% from 6,339 to 6,655.
  - Online learning enrollment is up 3% from 9,404 to 9,688.
  - Online learning sections offered is flat at 278.

- Student Ethnicity
  - Overall enrollment increased by 3% between Spring 2015 and Spring 2016.
  - Headcount among African Americans (-38), Whites (-65) and those who decline to state their ethnicity (-197) decreased but increased among Asians (+333), Latino/as (+152) and Filipinos (+101).

- Student Ethnicity among Continuing Students
  - Overall headcount among continuing students between Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 increased by 2% (+148).
  - Headcount among Latino/as (+139), Asians (+87) and Filipinos (+57) increased while White (-118) and African American (-20) headcount decreased.

- Student Population
  - The largest increase in headcount (+178) occurred among first time transfer students while the largest increase in estimated FTES (+28) occurred among first time new students.
  - From Spring 2015 and Spring 2016, enrollment among returning students from decreased in headcount (-51) while a decline in FTES (-1%) occurred among continuing students.

- Zip Code Grouping within Santa Clara County
  - Within Santa Clara County, African American student enrollment decreased among those from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (-5%) between Spring 2015 to Spring 2016 (99 to 94).
  - Within Santa Clara County, Filipino student enrollment increased by the largest percentage (16%) in “San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward, East Palo Alto” between Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 (304 to 353).
  - Within Santa Clara County, Latino/a student enrollment increased except among those from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, Saratoga” (557 to 540).

- International Students (F1)
  - Enrollment among F1 students increased from Spring 2015 and Spring 2016 by 5%, from 1,260 to 1,197.
  - Females represented 41% of all international students (F1 and FZ visa status) in Spring 2016 compared to 39% in Spring 2015 (+2%).
  - In Spring 2015 and Spring 2016, the top three countries of origin for international students included China (S15: 416 vs. S16: 433), Hong Kong (S15: 148 vs. S16: 124) and Indonesia (S15: 145 vs. S16: 101). These 3 countries of origin represent 55% of all F1 student enrollment.
  
- Applicants who Registered in Spring 2016
  - Almost half of the Spring 2016 applicants registered for the fall term (48%).
