

**51.6%** **Students who Voted**


**74.6%** **Registered Voters who Voted**

**Average Voting Rate National Comparators**


**Associates 43.6%**

Associates and bachelors degree granting institutions, 59/728 AA institutions participated, 12/135 public bachelors institutions participated.

Absentee voting is permanent vote by mail and voting by mail is based on request and ballot must be received 7 days prior to election day.
