From Winter 2011 at end-of-term to Winter 2012 at census:

- Enrollment
 - Resident and non-resident estimated WSCH is down 9% at 155,770.
 - Total headcount is down 6% at 12,846.
 - Resident WSCH is down 11% at 133,543.
 - Non-resident WSCH is up 4% at 22,227.
- Ethnicity
 - A new methodology was implemented beginning 2012W that no longer reports multi-ethnic as a category.
 - Using the new methodology, Hispanic students increased from 2011W at end-of-term from 1,435 to 2,469 in 2012W at census.
 - Asian students continue to represent one-quarter of the student population (26%).
- Enrollment Status
 - Continuing student headcount is down from last winter end-of-term from 10,647 to 10,008, a percentage rate change of -6%.
 - Returning student headcount is up from 1,579 to 2,058, a percentage rate change of 23%.
- Full-time/Part-time
 - Full-time students remain steady at around 30% from 2011W end-of-term (4,344) and 2012W at census (4,508).
- District of Residence
 - Enrollment of students from the Foothill service area remained stable at 25%, representing 3,624 students in 2012W at census.
- International Students
 - F1 student enrollment increased from 900 to 1005, a percentage point change of 10%.

- Total distance learning estimated WSCH is up 7% at 39,427.
 - Distance learning headcount is up 8% from 4,874 to 5,269.
 - Distance learning enrollment is up 9% from 7,081 to 7,686.
 - Distance learning sections offered is up 4% from 202 to 211.
