Palo Alto University Transfer Agreement 2011-2012 Catalog Requirements



Transfer students must successfully complete 90 quarter (60 semester) transferable units with a minimum 2.0 GPA\* to be considered for admission to Palo Alto University. Only courses with a grade of C or better will be accepted, though all transferable courses taken will count toward GPA calculation. Students at Palo Alto University are required to complete 90 additional quarter unit hours (totaling 180 quarter units) in order to obtain the Bachelor of Science degree.

Transfer students must complete either the California State University General Education/Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC for CSU) with grades of C or better in each course. Either pattern satisfies PAU's general education requirements.
