Stanford University's Phoenix Scholars Mentorship program, which offers guidance and support to low-income, first generation high school students, is offering similar services to community college students looking to transfer to a four-year university or college.



Have a mentor

Once accepted, community college students will receive guidance in applying to transfer, personal statements, resume development, searching for scholarships and be paired by a trained Stanford student mentor.

Eligibility Criteria

If you are:

- A low-income, first-generation, and/or an underrepresented minority full-time student with a 2.7 or higher G.P.A. and
- On track to apply to transfer by spring 2017

How to apply?

2. Turn in an unofficial transcript to your school's transfer center.
3. Make sure your school's transfer center verifies your status as a low-income, first-generation and/or underrepresented minority student.
