Hi Andrew,

In fall 2016, F1 students accounted for about 8% of total credit headcount. I used the F1 IDs at census and joined them with end of term headcount (not much difference in F1 HC). Credit headcount omits AP, JRYM, LINC, PA, PCA and non-credit.

F1 (% of Credit Headcount, End of Term)

fall 2011 = 6.6% (954 of 14,524)

fall 2012 = 8.1% (1,114 of 13,725)

fall 2013 = 8.5% (1,130 of 13,327)

fall 2014 = 9.0% (1,201 of 13,272)

fall 2015 = 8.8% (1,193 of 13,618)

fall 2016 = 7.5% (1,002 of 13,397)
