Did You Know?

Applicants that Enrolled

56% of 2018-19 applicants enrolled at at Foothill

Average Units Earned

Average units earned by first-time degree earners in 2019-20 is about 104 units

Completion of Transfer Level English and Math

Among students entering in Fall 2018, 14% completed transfer English and Math by the end of the year

Persistence

First time students entering Foothill in 2018, 61% persisted and enrolled again in Winter 2019

Median Time to Degree

Among first time degree earners, in 2019-20 is 3 years

*These numbers represent different students at different points in time, using various methodologies

Preventing Loss/Creating Momentum

Defining the **Student Experience**



The “student experience” is defined as the series of interactions between the student and the college.



Starts when prospective students make a connection with higher education and continues through to that student’s exit.

During this journey, students: interact with college personnel, college structures and systems, and college policies.

Preventing Loss/Creating Momentum

Four Phases

Connection: initial interest through submitting application/gathering info

Entry: arrive at the institution, onramp to a program of study

Progress: move from initial engagement with college, to long term commitment

Completion: attainment of her/his end goals

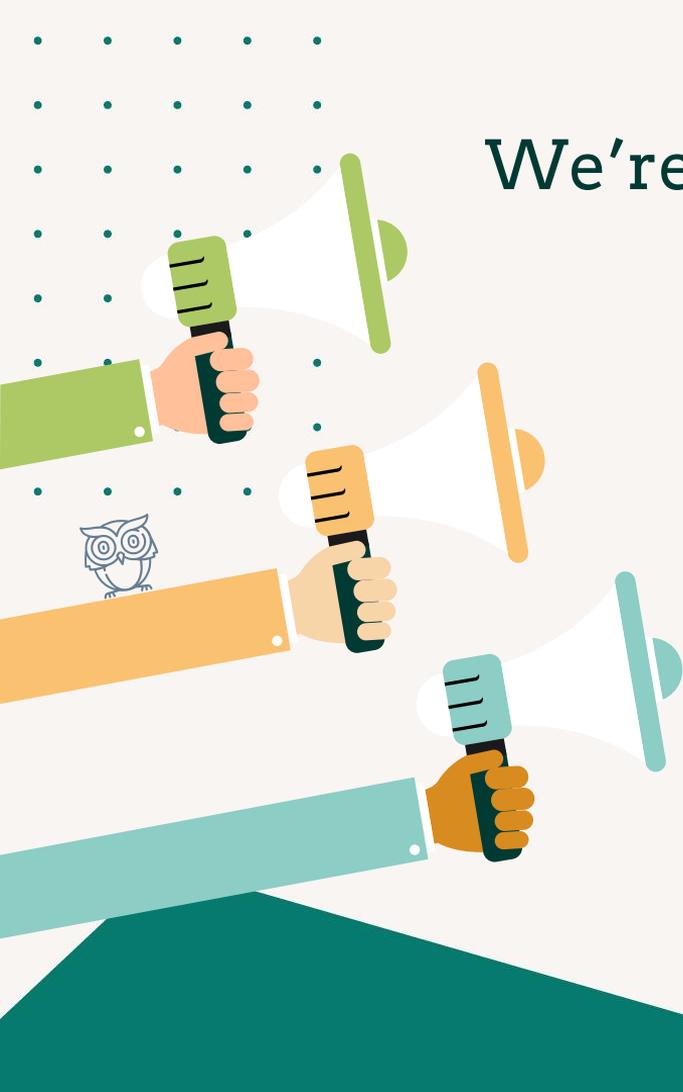

What is a Mission and Why is it Important?

A **mission statement** is a short statement of

- why an organization exists
- what its overall goal is
- identifying the goal of its operations
- who you serve
- how you serve them

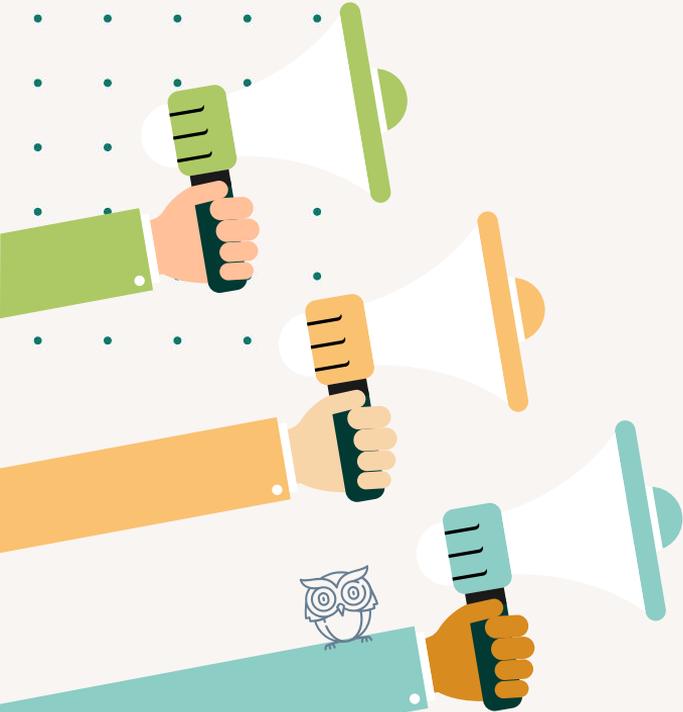
