

The Fine Print...

What are the benefits of earning an AA-T or AS-T degree?

- Guaranteed admissions with junior standing to the CSU system (not guaranteed to a particular campus or major)
- Priority admissions consideration for students' local CSU campus or to a program that is deemed similar to a student's community college major (not guaranteed admissions to a specific major or campus).
- This degree may not be the best option for students intending to transfer to a particular CSU campus or to a university or college that is not part of the CSU system. A counselor can help you decide.
- Research shows that students who earn an associate degree prior to transfer are more likely to graduate with a 4-year degree.

What are the requirements to earn an AA-T or AS-T Degree?

- Complete all req'd courses on either the CSU General Education-Breadth or IGETC GE patterns.
- Complete the required major requirements for the AA-T or AS-T major. All courses in the major must be completed with a grade of C or better.
- Complete a minimum of 90 CSU

- Request final transcripts to be sent to your CSU

The Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

A new type of degree available from California community colleges, specifically designed for use by students transferring as juniors to the CSU system!

What can the Associate Degree for Transfer program do for you?

- Guarantees your admission with junior standing to the California State University system.
- Provides a degree that includes 90 transferable units (a minimum of 27 units in a major or area of emphasis and an approved general education curriculum-either IGETC or CSU GE Breadth).
- Guarantees you receive priority admission consideration to your local California State University campus and to a program or major that is similar to the major or area of emphasis you completed at Foothill College.
- Promises that you won't have to repeat courses that are similar to those completed Foothill College as part of your Associate Degree for Transfer.
- Guarantees that you will not have to take more than 60 semester units to complete a 120-semester unit baccalaureate degree after transfer. (Students who change their major after transfer lose the unit guarantee.)
- Shortens your time to degree completion and reduces your costs at both the community college and California State University.
- Eliminates confusion caused by different major preparation requirements that can vary by each California State University campus.
- The ADT is not accepted for all majors or specializations at all CSUs: see ADegreeWithAGuarantee.com for details.
