

Assessment Testing | ESLL Course Sequence

Foothill Assessment Testing Rules:

- Assessment test scores are valid for one
 (1) year.
- Students can take a retest within six (6)
 months of earning their initial assessment if
 they have not earned a transcriptable grade
 in the course sequence that they wish to
 retest in.
- Highly recommended! Students should submit their official high school transcripts to Admissions & Records for a more accurate assessment.
