## Foothill College Placement Testing

Pretest Questions

Foothill College considers your high school academic record, in addition to your Accuplacer test scores, when determining your placement. For placement purposes, your high school transcript could be requested by the college to verify your pretest self-reported answers.

## Failure to produce your transcript, upon request, could alter your placement.

There will be an option for you to specify you student status if you are:

- An international student studying in the U.S.; and/or
- You went to high school outside of the U.S.; and/or
- You have not yet completed 11<sup>th</sup> Grade (Junior Year of High School).

# MATH & ENGLISH PRETEST QUESTIONS

- If you are <u>still in high school</u>, what was your **unweighted high school GPA (grade point average) through 11th** grade\*? (GPA options of 4.0 through 1.0)
- If you <u>completed</u> high school, what was your **unweighted** high school GPA (grade point average)\*? (GPA options of 4.0 through 1.0)

### MATH ONLY PRETEST QUESTIONS

- What is the **highest** math course you completed? If you have not yet completed high school, this would typically be the math course that you took in 11th grade or earlier.
- What is the **highest** math course you passed with a '**C**' **grade** or better? If you have not yet completed high school, this would typically be the course you took in 11th grade or earlier.

### ENGLISH ONLY PRETEST QUESTIONS

- What grade did you receive in your 11th Grade English course? (Grades A through NP)
- What grade did you receive in your **12th Grade English course**? (Grades A through NP)

\*An unweighted grade point average (GPA) is a GPA that is based upon the 0.00 to 4.00 scale; this GPA does not include honors courses, AP courses, etc.
