- New Curriculum System Selected: We are excited to announce that Foothill has selected a new curriculum system! CourseLeaf (by Leepfrog) will replace C3MS, as well as streamline our production of the college catalog. We are putting together an implementation team, and we expect to begin meeting with Leepfrog in early November. Are you interested in joining the implementation team? - Changes to Certificate of Achievement Categories: Over the summer, the state Chancellor's Office approved changes to the total units allowed for the two categories of certificates of achievement. We are now required to submit to the state any certificate with a minimum of 24 quarter units (previously a minimum of 27). In addition, we now have the option to submit any certificate with a total of 12-23 quarter units (that range was previously 18-26). The Office of Instruction has distributed to the CCC Reps a list of Foothill certificates affected by these changes, and CCC will be devising a process for changing a non-transcriptable certificate to a certificate of achievement.
