- ❖ Additions to Foothill GE: The following courses were approved on February 1st for Foothill GE for 2022-23:
 - ♦ Area I—Humanities: ENGL 10A, HUMN 10, HUMN 14
 - ♦ Area II—English: ESLL 26 (reactivation)
- ❖ Minimum Proficiency in English for Local AA/AS Degrees: The Language Arts division has updated the language for the minimum proficiency in English for local AA/AS degrees to add the option of ESLL 26, which is being reactivated and was included as an option before its deactivation in 2018. The new language was approved by CCC on February 1st and will go into effect with the 2022-23 catalog. If you have any questions, please contact your CCC Reps. - ❖ Resolution to Approve the Foothill College Meta Major Model: On February 1st, CCC held a first read of a resolution which, if approved, would support moving forward with the proposed Foothill College Meta Major Model. The group welcomed guests from the Guided Pathways Team for the discussion, who shared details about the campus-wide collaborative process used to gather feedback from students, faculty, and staff, which informed the groupings of certificates and degrees within the seven Meta Majors. As explained by our guests, approval of the proposed model would solidify the groupings within the Meta Majors, for the first few years, after which time the college will reflect on what has worked and what hasn't, and discuss making adjustments to the model.
