- New Certificate Applications: At the May 23rd meeting, CCC approved an application for the following new certificate, which will be sent to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at an upcoming meeting:
 Certificate of Achievement in Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) Technician
- Degree or Certificate (Program) Discontinuance Process: At the May 23rd meeting, CCC approved a formal approval process for the discontinuance (AKA deactivation) of a degree or certificate. The process has been posted on the CCC Policies & Resolutions webpage. Additionally, the Degree or Certificate Process & Resources webpage has been updated to add a section related to discontinuance.
- Process to Implement Guiding Principles for Equitable CORs: Also at the May 23rd meeting, CCC continued discussing the adoption of our equity guidelines across all academic divisions. The primary option under consideration is the addition of text field to the COR form in CourseLeaf, in which faculty would describe any work they've done to incorporate the equity guidelines into their COR. The group reviewed a mock-up of this text field, and we plan to hold a first read of an updated version at our next meeting.
