- ❖ Additions to Foothill GE: On February 27th, CCC approved three applications from the Apprenticeship division to map the major requirements for a degree program to a Foothill GE area. Unlike the usual GE application process, these approvals are not specific to one individual course; instead, any student who completes the full major requirements for the degree will fulfill the GE area (beginning in 2024-25).

- ❖ Equity in the COR Why and How: At the February 27th meeting, CCC held a first read of this document, which condenses our <u>Guiding Principles for Equitable CORs</u> document into something more digestible, providing the "why" and "how" of incorporating equity into six sections of the COR. The document will return for a second read and possible action at the March 12th meeting. If you haven't had the opportunity to review it yet, or if you'd like to provide feedback ahead of the second read, please reach out to your CCC Reps and/or Ben.
- Resolution to Extend Student Graduation Petition Deadline: Also during the February 27th meeting, CCC held a first read of a resolution, proposed by one of the CCC Reps, to ask Foothill College to extend the March 1st deadline for students' graduation petitions, ensure students are fully aware of the opportunities they have to receive a degree or certificate, and explore ways to improve the petition process for students. During the first read discussion, CCC members from the Counseling department provided additional information about the graduation petition deadlines and context for the March 1st deadline as it relates to a deadline set by the CSU system. The resolution is being updated to focus on supporting students to meet the current deadlines and will return for a second read and possible action on March 12th.
