News & Announcements:

- ❖ **Changing our Catalog Start Term:** It's official—we are changing the start term for our academic catalog from summer to fall, **effective for the 2026-27 catalog**. The upcoming 2025-26 catalog will still begin with summer 2025 and will also include the summer 2026 term; the following catalog will begin with fall 2026 and cover fall through summer. This change does not affect the academic calendar or fiscal year.

The upcoming June 20th deadline for CORs for 2026-27 remains the same, and the default Effective Term for those CORs has been updated to fall 2026 in CourseLeaf. Mary will update the Effective Term to fall 2026 on any CORs which are already making their way through the process. - ❖ **Degree Deactivation:** On March 18th, CCC approved the deactivation of the Associate in Science in Public Health Science for Transfer Degree (ADT), which is being replaced with the new Public Health ADT. This change will go into effect for the 2025-26 catalog.
- ❖ **Courses not Taught in Four Years:** In keeping with our annual process related to course currency, at the March 18th meeting CCC reviewed the deactivation exemption request forms submitted by divisions for courses on this year's list. - ❖ **General Education Options for a Foothill College Associate's Degree:** At the March 18th meeting, CCC passed an updated resolution to allow students the option of using the new Cal-GETC transfer GE pattern to satisfy GE requirements for a local AA or AS degree. The original resolution was passed in May

2011, to allow students to use the IGETC and CSU GE patterns—these will still be options for students who have the appropriate catalog rights for previous catalog years. And, of course, our local Foothill GE pattern will continue to be an option for students completing a local AA or AS degree. - *Friday, June 20th*: Deadline to submit CORs for all new courses and course updates for 2026-27 in CourseLeaf CIM (must be in "Curriculum Coordinator Review1" status by this date)
 - Important Note: CORs for any new courses or revisions being submitted for UC transfer approval must be in "Curriculum Coordinator Review1" status by the earlier deadline of Monday, June 2nd.
