- ❖ **Foothill GE Application Criteria for Area 5:** At the February 3rd meeting, CCC continued work on refining the criteria for each area of the new Foothill General Education pattern by discussing the criteria and application form for Area 5 Natural Sciences (with Lab). The discussion touched on specific language used in one of the depth outcomes, and the group also discussed maintaining the current format of including separate outcomes for lecture and lab. Additionally, the group continued discussing the current format of requiring the same number of mandatory and optional outcomes for each GE application.

At our next meeting, on February 17th, we will discuss Area 6 Ethnic Studies. Once all areas have been discussed and suggested edits compiled, all of the updated application forms will be voted on at CCC.

- ❖ **Foothill GE Application Breadth Criteria and Mapping:** At the February 3rd meeting, CCC held a first read of updated Breadth Criteria and Breadth Mapping, to be included on all Foothill GE application forms. Breadth mapping is intended to demonstrate alignment of a course (or degree program) with Foothill's Institutional Learning Outcomes, and the group brainstormed various ways of formatting this section of the application forms. The goal is to provide faculty submitting an application with clear instructions on how to best demonstrate alignment, which will aid CCC in reviewing submissions. This document is still a work in progress, and we encourage your input! Please reach out to your Curriculum Reps or Ben to review the current draft and provide feedback.
