- Honors course in the past that can be reactivated
- Credit for prior learning summit
 - Work group membership needed
 - Push incorporate credit for prior learning
 - Limbo state, how can we be part of this process
 - Will faculty get load or credit for teaching
 - Faculty
 - Counseling
 - Pay for teaching non credit
 - Interest in veterans how to translate their experience into credit, timely responsible way
 - What is our responsibility as faculty to this?
 - Correlated push for non credit courses where credit can be received?
- Non transcriptable certs
 - Push to add non transcriptable certs as possible, several years ago (2014)
 - Now new funding formula is related to transcriptable certs
 - Non transcriptable certs are meaning to students, community members, and potential employers
 - Who are we serving – state line or autonomy?
 - How do we decide which to keep and which to convert?
 - Discontinued a phot non transcript cert
 - Made transcript cert of that – all in phot are transcript cert
 - Lower unit cert/stackable transcript. Cert
 - Earn along the way to AA – staging students into the degree
 - Challenge for admin asst (sheherazade)
 - COMM had non transcript cert
 - Resisted to have lower unit/stackable
 - Once lowered, then converted to transcript. Cert
 - Eligible for financial aid
 - Been a good process
 - Positive change for the student to be transcript
 - If this is being pushed – there were numerous training sessions on how to set up non transcript/transcript. Cert
 - Having more workshops/trainings would be helpful
 - Oppy to develop more transcript. Certs in a workshop
 - Funding purposes – let's get instruction/PD
 - Is it a simple request?
