

ON CAMPUS ASFC ELECTIONS POSTING POLICY REMINDERS

Campaigning begins on Tuesday, April 21. NO CAMPAIGNING OF ANY KIND IS PERMITTED PRIOR TO APRIL 21 and continues through the election period which closes on April 29. Online voting will begin on Monday, April 27, 2026, and conclude on Wednesday, April 29.

During this time, the campus posting policy will be modified to accommodate election materials.

EACH CANDIDATE IS PROVIDED A FREE POSTER PACKAGE FROM DESIGN CENTER. ONE LARGE POSTER, ONE MEDIUM SIZED POSTER AND 25 SHEETS OF QUARTER SIZED HANDOUTS (100 TOTAL). NO OTHER FLIERS OR POSTERS ARE ALLOWED. ONE POSTER PER LOCATION PER CANDIDATE. TAMPERING WITH FELLOW CANDIDATE POSTERS IS PROHIBITED AND IS GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION. DO NOT REMOVE OR RELOCATE ANY CANDIDATE FLIERS OR POSTERS OTHER THAN YOUR OWN.

Campus Center (Building 2000)

No approval stamp is needed. Students may post anywhere in the Campus Center, with the exception of the following: NO POSTING ON any wood surfaces, painted surfaces, windows/doors and bathroom walls and stalls.

Main Campus

An approval stamp is not needed for flies designed or printed in the ASFC Design Center with the ASFC logo, no approval stamp is needed. Materials may NOT be posted on any painted or wood surfaces, trees, or lampposts.

No lawn signage is allowed. Posting is prohibited on the footbridge as it obstructs vehicle traffic. Students may request to post on division/department boards and approval is at the discretion of the supervising administrator.

Classroom Announcements

Candidates may request to make classroom announcements, either in person, or online. Approval is REQUIRED in advance by the instructor and is at the discretion of the individual faculty member. Classroom announcements are limited to one minute in length.

Chalk Art on sidewalks is Prohibited.

All material must be removed by Friday, May 1.
