A FUN AND SOCIAL TRANSITION INTO COLLEGE



The Summer College Readiness Program is five weeks of college preparation in a casual setting so you can experience:

- **An introduction to the EOPS program:** Learn about the extensive support services provided to program participants with an overview of the program's history and guidelines to remain in compliance.
- **Instruction that sharpens your study skills:** Develop lifelong learning strategies to equip you with practical skills that are crucial for college survival.
- **Q & A with current EOPS students and alumni:** Learn from students who've been in your shoes and who have first hand knowledge to assist you with transitioning to college.
- **An orientation to campus resources:** Prior to the start of fall quarter visit and learn about additional student support and academic resources on campus. You will work directly with a counselor to approach and solidify your academic goals
- **A fun and social transition into college:** Meet new students like yourself and make connections before starting in the fall.

How to Qualify for the Program

- You must be a first-time college student, or have minimal college experience
- Complete the Foothill College application at foothill.edu/admission
- Apply for financial aid at foothill.edu/aid. *All EOPS students must be eligible for the California College Promise Grant (formerly known as BOG fee waiver) A or B, or meet method B criteria if qualified for CC Promise Grant waiver C. Apply by submitting a California College Promise Grant application or the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).*
- Meet at least one of the California state EOPS program's eligibility criteria to be determined at your appointment

What is EOPS?

EOPS provides “over and above” academic support and services to full-time students who qualify for the California College Promise Grant and meet the program's eligibility criteria. Our goal is to provide you with accessible resources in a supportive environment to help you reach your academic and career aspirations.

Services include:

- individualized counseling
- tutoring
- computer lab access with printing privileges
- four-year university campus tours
- UC/CSU transfer admission application fee waivers
