- Evaluation of college planning
 - EMP, Facilities Master Plan, Tech Plan, Distance Ed, etc.
- Accreditation
 - Institutional Set Standards (effectiveness + methodology)
 - Subcommittee for Midterm report, ISER, Follow up report (if needed)
