Mission Informed Planning Council (MIPC)

- Purpose & Purview
 - Advise and consult with the college president
 - Assure mission, vision, core values are embodied in decision-making process
 - Review strategic plans to ensure alignment
 - Develop and operationalize college-wide guiding principles for decision-making
 - Oversee strategy and execution of the Educational Master Plan
