Update:

May 4, 2021 – Facilities Master Plan Study Group met and discussed:

- Developing a process for prioritizing facilities projects not funded by Measure G funds
 - Foothill's estimated allocation is \$175 million
- Identify capital projects for possible funding
 - Program Review Budget Requests (\$11.45 million)
 - Facilities Assessment Report (Due in August 2021)
 - Projects funded by donations (i.e. Japanese Cultural Center & Azumaya)
- Identify funding sources for the projects including:
 - Measure C Funds (Approx. \$5.6 million)
 - Capital Funds (Approx. \$6 million)
 - Donated Funds (\$130,000 for the JCC & Azumaya)
 - Deferred Maintenance ??? (2021-22 State Budget)
- Bring list of prioritized projects to R & R for a recommendation



Stakeholder Input:

Discussed using a similar process to the Program Review Budget Request Process, but needing further information and input:

- Include stakeholders as part of the facilities project review
- Would like to have the following come to the Study Group meeting from the programs that are requesting the facilities projects
