Guided Pathways Goal


Highly structured approach to student success that provides all students with a set of clear course-taking patterns to promote better enrollment decisions and prepare students for future success.

Connection

From Interest in college enrollment to application

Entry

Enrollment to completion of first college-level course

Progress

Entry into program of study to 75% of requirement completion

Completion

Complete program of study to credential with labor market value

 - Meta Majors = Progress

Data & Tech Team Objectives

- Conduct tech landscape analysis
- Support data requests
- Identify data that inform efforts narrowing student outcome gaps (no DI)
- Advocate data production in an efficient, timely, and reasonable manner
- Ensure GP/Equity 2.0 alignment

Data & Tech Team Role

- Advisory Group (meet as needed)
 - Remove tech silos
 - Streamline platforms
- Data Advisor (meet regularly)
 - Recommend/Identify data for decision-making

Data & Tech Team Logistics

- Hold team meetings
- Embedded in other teams
 - Semi-directed approach
 - Recommend options/opportunities

Data & Tech Approach

- Discover: Tell me more & what works?
- Dream: What are we aiming toward?
- Design: How can we get closer?
- Deliver: What data/tech might help lead to action?
