You have been directed to the guided self-placement for math because you did not attend a high school that used an American style 4.0 grade point average (GPA) scale which is the standard Foothill College uses for placement. Reasons for not having a high school GPA: you went to high school outside of the United States, you never attended high school at all, or your high school used a different grading scale.

Since you do not have an American style high school GPA, you will self-place yourself into one of our math classes based on your confidence level in mathematics. In this Guided Self-placement you will complete the following:

- 1) Complete self-diagnostics and review course material
- 2) Learn about the math courses offered at Foothill College
- 3) Learn about the various Math Pathways
- 4) Choose an appropriate math course based on your major, educational goals, and mathematics confidence level.
