RE:	Course Registration Satisfaction Survey – Spring 2018

### <u>Overview</u>

The survey was distributed online via email to students who registered for one or more courses during Spring 2018. Student responses were captured between March 13<sup>th</sup> and April 13<sup>th</sup>. Five questions were listed. Students were asked for their satisfaction with the overall registration process and whether they were able to register for their intended courses. Students could also request follow up by providing their name and contact information. A total of 430 respondents completed the survey with 52 (12%) of those requesting follow up.

### **Highlights**

- The majority of respondents (360/430; 84%) reported being either "Very Satisfied" or "Somewhat Satisfied" with their experience registering for courses.
- The majority of respondents (339/426; 80%) reported being able to register for all of the classes they were looking to take.
- The top challenge to registering for courses for a quarter of respondents whom could not register for their courses (45/179; 25%) was the courses in question being full.
- The second top challenge to registering for courses, reported by 32 of 179 respondents (18%), was that the course they needed was not offered at the time they needed.
