

Student Gender, Age, First Gen





Access to Transfer-Level Courses


 Open enrollment into transferlevel English and Math

 Increased access→increased number of students passing transfer-level Math and English

Completion Outcomes

- Students who complete career and technical education coursework w/o transferring experience a wage increase (\$23.63/hr median increase).
- In 2023-24: 756 AA, AS, and ADT degrees awarded; 1,153 certificates of achievement awarded; 59 BS degrees awarded (Dental Hygiene)
