Ben Stefonik and I would like to invite you to attend a forum on the topic of Chat GPT, which will be held **Wed. 3/1 11:30-12:30pm via Zoom**. It will be led by Ben's students.

From Ben:

This quarter my Psyc/Soc 7 Statistics for the Behavioral Science class is developing a class project to investigate issues surrounding the AI chatbot Chat GPT as it relates to education. As you may be aware, <u>Chat GPT</u> is a substantial advancement in generative AI technology. It presents both exciting new pedagogical opportunities, as well as real and acute concerns about academic integrity, as it has the capabilities of completing many types of academic assessments. If you have not engaged with Chat GPT, I encourage you to check it out to understand its capabilities.

This quarter, I am taking this opportunity to offer students an authentic learning experience to show how we can use research methods and stats to answer important questions. My class will be developing two survey tools - one for students and one for faculty - to gather insights and explore questions in the following vein:

- How many students know about/are using Chat GPT?
- When/why are students inclined to use it to complete assignments?
- What do students think about the ethicality of it? Do students view it as cheating?
- How do students think it can enhance or benefit learning?
- What do faculty think about how to address academic integrity issues?
- How can Chat GPT be incorporated into assignments and classroom instruction?
- Will this lead to the development of new norms/standards around the origin of academic work (computer generated vs human generated)?

The goal of this project is to gather information that could be helpful to the Foothill community in developing a response to this technology. We plan to obtain representative samples from student and faculty bodies. My class and I will present the findings in a forum that will be held **Wed. 3/1**, **11:30-12:30pm via Zoom**.

Do you know we have two Foothill alums who are Marshall Scholars?


