STRATEGIC INITIATIVES and EDUCATIONAL MASTER PLAN

- January 26 Strategic Initiative Planning Committees (SIP) and Operations Planning Council (OPC) joint meeting; outline process and review calendar; review Resource Request Form
- February 5 Ed Master Plan Goals Template distributed to SIP groups for use in completing strategic initiative goals
- February 24 SIP groups submit completed Goals Template for inclusion in Ed Master Plan
- March 5 Full draft of Ed Master Plan to SIP groups and participatory governance groups
- March 17 First discussion of Ed Master Plan at PaRC
- March 19 SIP groups and participatory governance groups submit feedback on draft of Ed Master Plan
- April 7 Second discussion of Ed Master Plan at PaRC (possible approval with minor revisions)
- April 21 Alternate Ed Master Plan approval date (following additional reviews, as needed)

RESOURCE ALLOCATION

- March 12 Divisions and areas submit completed prioritization of requests to SIP groups
- March 16 SIP groups joint meeting for 1st hour; training on prioritization process and considerations
- March 16 through April 30 SIP groups complete prioritizations; OPC reviews requests in light of existing funding protocols, restrictions, & requirements; OPC identifies available funding
- April 21 PaRC reviews Perkins funding recommendations
- April 30 SIP groups submit completed prioritization of requests to PaRC; OPC shares funding availability advisory information
- May 5 PaRC and OPC joint meeting; PaRC reviews full list of priorities from SIP groups; opportunity to ask questions on process or funding options; Round 1 priority rankings follow mtg (due Friday May 14)
- May 19 PaRC discussion of Round 1 priority rankings; Round 2 priority rankings follow mtg (due Friday May 28)
- June 2 PaRC discussion of Round 2 priority rankings; final recommendations to President
- June 16 President shares resource allocation plan following review of PaRC recommendations
