RE: Basic Skills Survey Results

Overview

The Basic Skills Survey was developed by the Basic Skills Workgroup, and Institutional Research & Planning assisted with the formatting and analysis of the survey and its results. The survey was administered as a pencil and paper process beginning January 13, 2011 through January 24, 2011. Announcements were made in the English and Math departments to encourage faculty to administer the survey in class. A total of 1557 surveys were distributed in the English department (n=510), Math department (n=802), one ALD class (n=45), Pass the Torch (n=120), and EOPS (n=80). A total of 499 surveys were returned and tabulated for a response rate of 32%.

Highlights

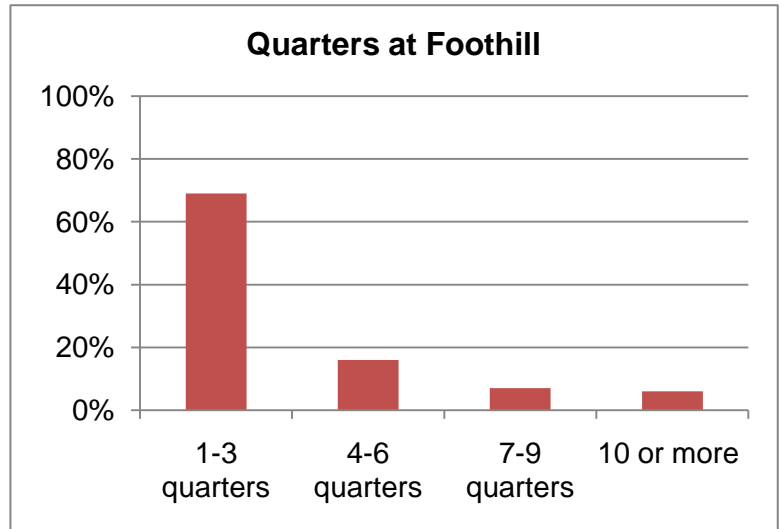
- The majority of survey respondents are fairly new to Foothill College, having only been enrolled between one to three quarters (69%).
- Seventy-nine percent of students are attending Foothill with the intention of transferring to a four-year institution, earning a degree or certificate, or improving their current skills set.
- Other reasons mentioned for attending Foothill include sports (n=18 or 2% of total responses) and the quarter system (n=5 or 0.5% of total responses).
- Over half of the students are on campus at least 11 hours a week (56%).
- Over three-fourths of the students are taking 10 or more units in Winter 2011 (78%).
- The best time block for students to receive academic support services is between noon-3 pm (34%), followed by 3-5 pm (19%) and 10-noon (18%).
- About half of the students indicated that their first Math course at Foothill was Math 105 (28%) or Math 200/221 (25%).
- English 100 was the first English course taken at Foothill for a majority of the student respondents (59%).
- The top three academic support services used by the student respondents are:
 - Counseling (24%),
 - Library services (22%), and
 - Media Center (12%).

- The majority of students indicated that they found out about academic support services by:
 - Word of mouth (25%),
 - Instructor suggestion (25%), and
 - Walking by (24%).
- Counselors also served as another resource that helped students find out about academic support services (n=36 or 4% of total responses).
- Eighty-four percent of students feel they would be “somewhat likely” or “very likely” to use an academic support service if their instructor/professor felt it would be beneficial.
- At least half of the survey respondents have never repeated a course at Foothill (54%).
- For students who did repeat a course, 69% did not use academic support services, but of those students who did use academic support services, 70% felt it increased their confidence to pass the course they were repeating.
- Limited time was the top reason for students to stop using (26%) or to never have used academic support services (30%).

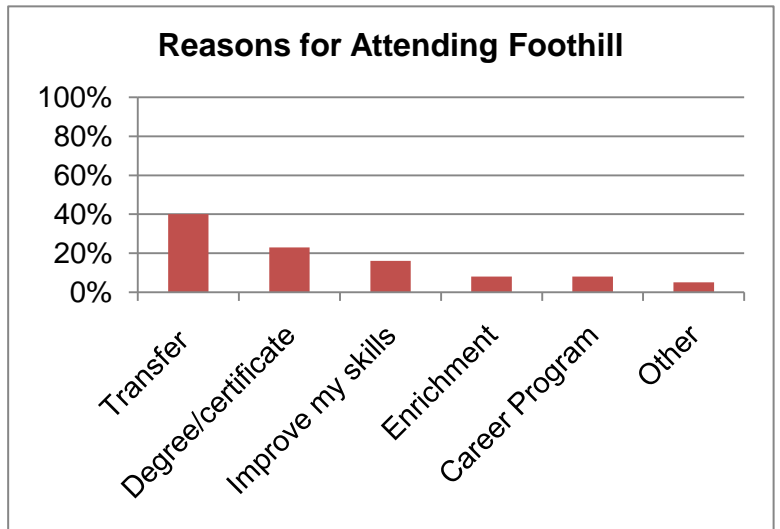

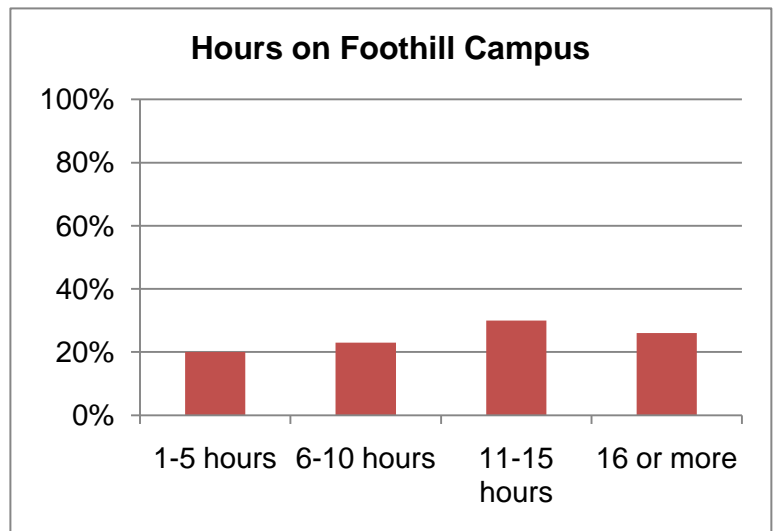

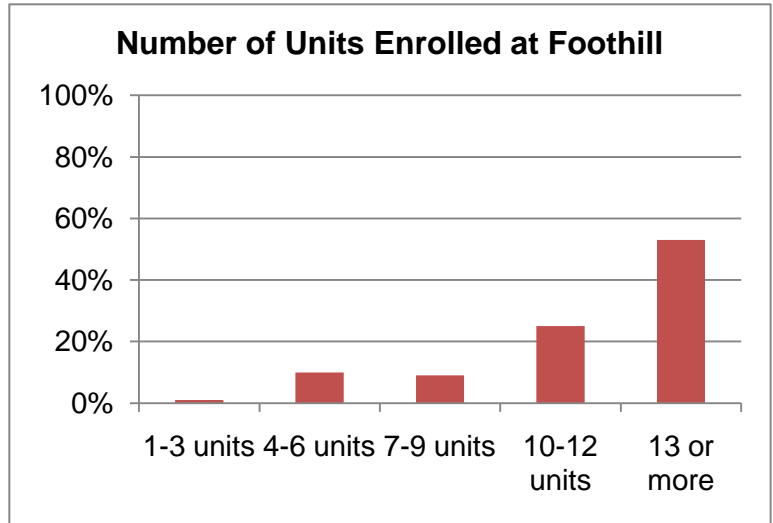
3. How many hours are you on campus?

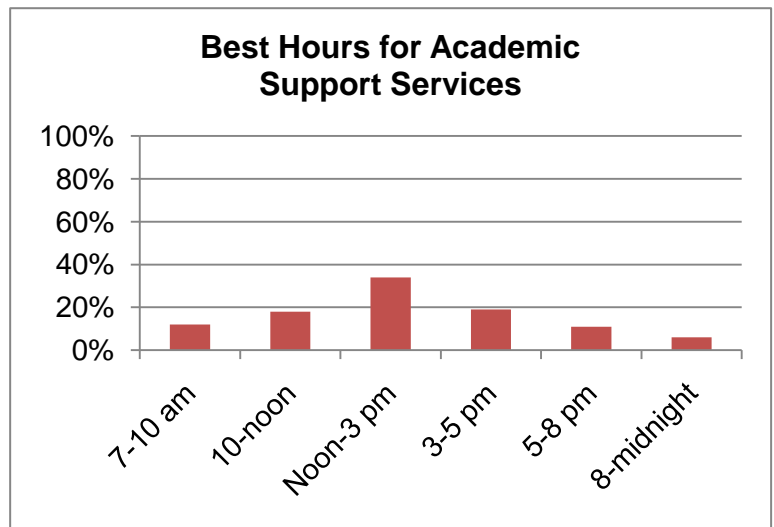
4. What number of units are you currently taking?

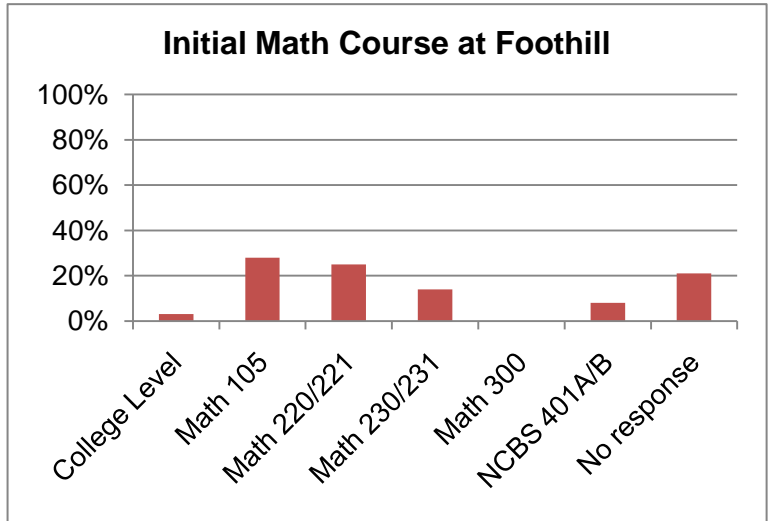
5. What are the best hours for you to receive academic support services? Check all that apply.

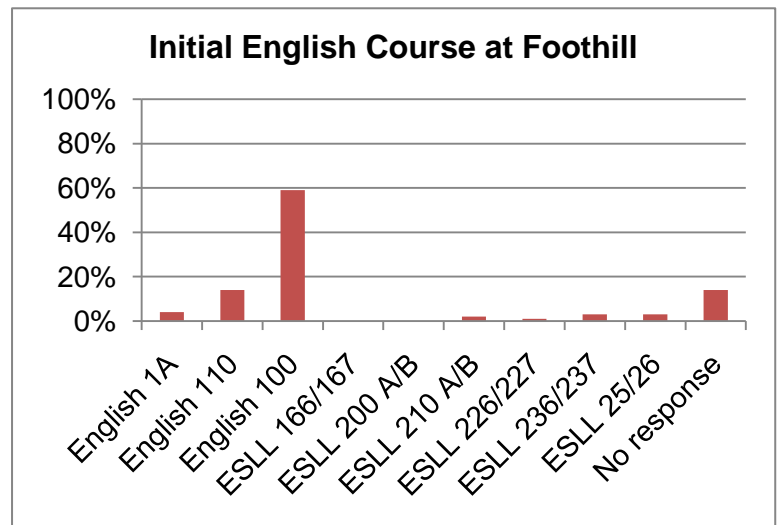

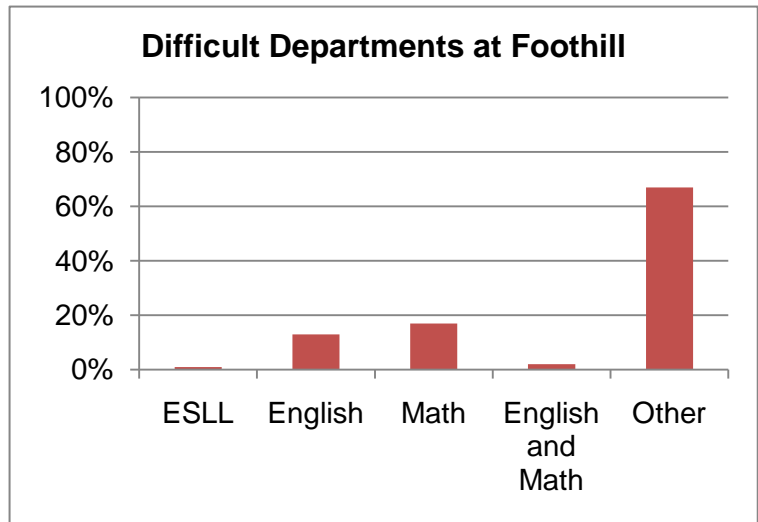

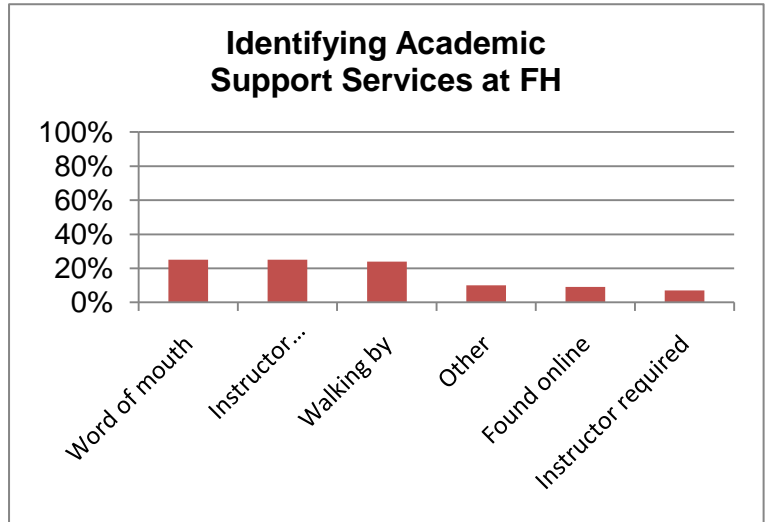

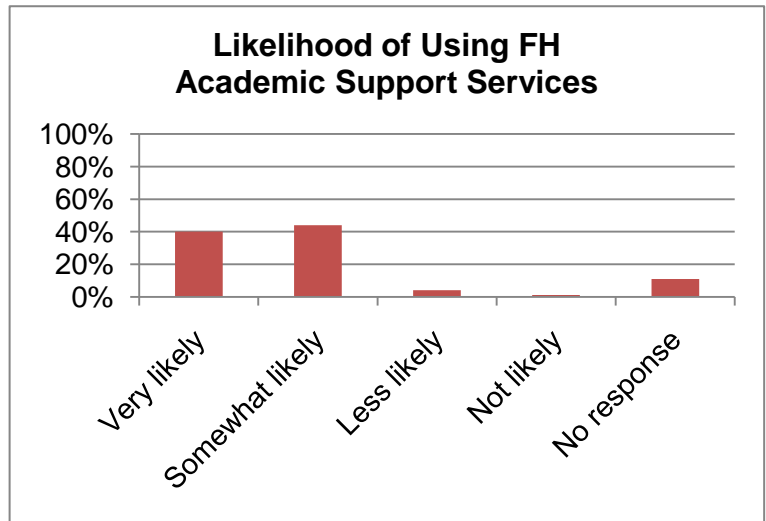

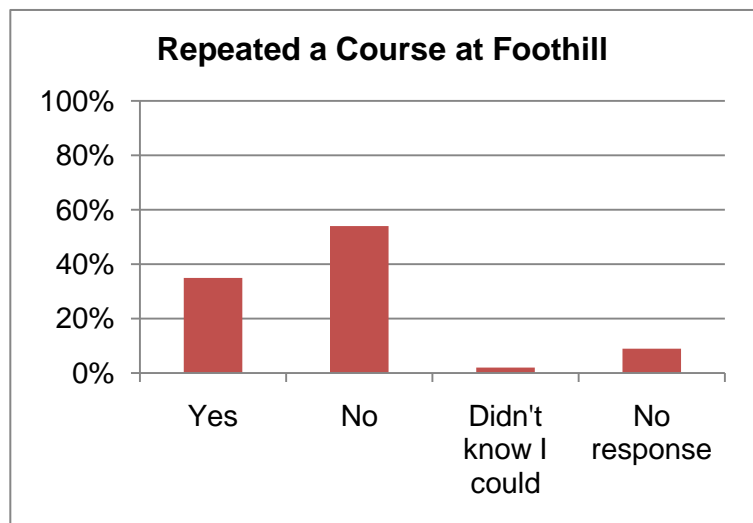
11. If your instructor/professor felt you would benefit from an academic support service, how likely would you be to use it?

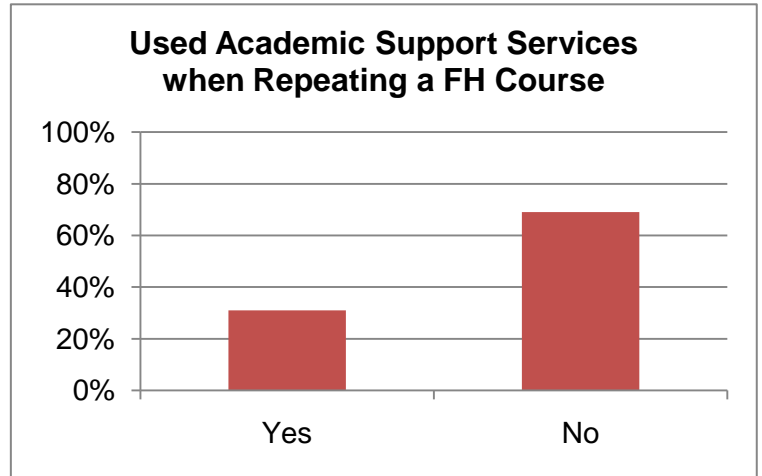
12. Have you ever repeated a course?

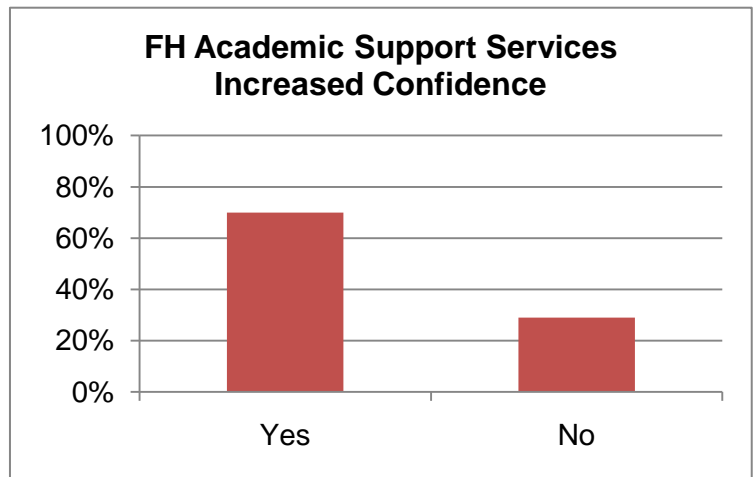
12a. If you repeated a course, did you use academic support services?

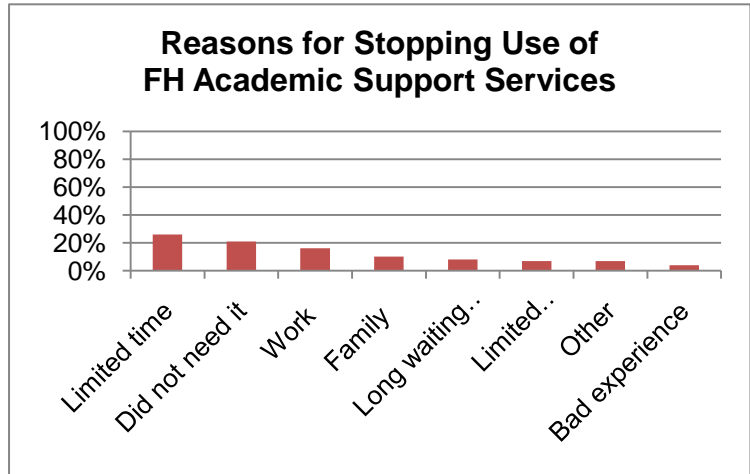
12b. If yes, did those services help you feel more confident in passing the class you were repeating?

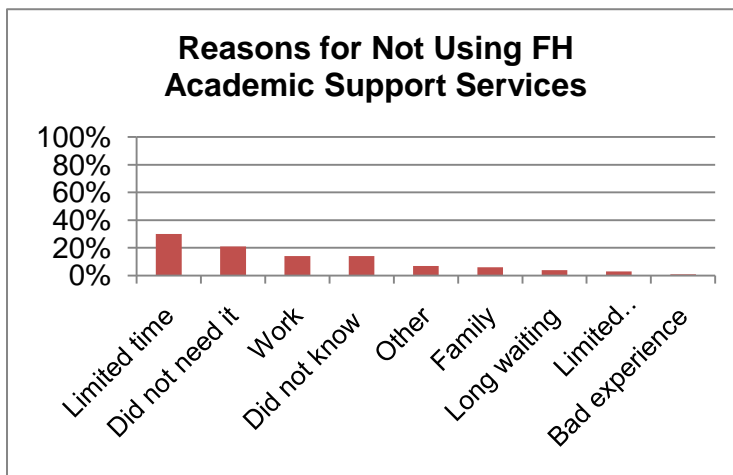
