Institution-Set Standards

- Student Achievement Data
 - Course completion rate
 - Retention percentage
 - Degree completion number
 - Transfer to 4-yr institutions
 - Certificate completion number
- College to set standards based on data and discussion

What is a standard?

- ACCJC
 - “...to meet educational quality and institutional effectiveness expectations”
 - “reasonable”
- Different from benchmark or goal
- College should annually meet and easily exceed—
at minimum
- Implications of not meeting standards may
require action plan to get back “up” to standard

Foothill Approach

- Data
 - Most recent term/year (Fall 2012 or 2011-12)
 - Longitudinal (2007-08 to 2011-12)
 - Disaggregation (ethnicity, program)
- Sources
 - CCCCO Data Mart, FHDA IR&P
- Discussion

 - Documentation

Standard Recommendations

Student Course Completion

Table 1. Student Course Completion Rate

Fall 2012	75%
Five-Year Average	76%
Five-Year Average by Ethnicity-Low	61%
Five-Year Average by Program-Low	60%
Institutional Standard Recommendation	55%

- Completion based on passing course with A, B, C, or P grade; includes all courses offered in Fall term
- Fall rates:
 - 2011: 74%
 - 2010: 76%
 - 2009: 77%
 - 2008: 79%

Student Retention

Table 2. Student Retention Percentage

Fall 2011 to Fall 2012	61%
Five-Year Average	57%
Five-Year Average by Ethnicity-Low	46%

Institutional Standard Recommendation	50%

- Retention based on first-time new student cohort
- Fall to Fall rates:
 - 2010-11: 62%
 - 2009-10: 61%
 - 2008-09: 48%
 - 2007-08: 54%

Student Degree Completion

Student Transfer to Four-Year

Table 4. Student Transfer to Four-Year Colleges/Universities

Percentage of Transfer Cohort	56%
Five-Year Average	483
Institutional Standard Recommendation	375

- Cohort based on first-time students who are evaluated 6 years after initial enrollment with the following:
 - Completed 12 credit units
 - Attempted transfer-level math or English
- Determination of how many within cohort transferred
- Cohort Number & Rate:
 - 2005-06: 391, 57%
 - 2004-05: 415, 55%
 - 2003-04: 373, 59%
 - 2002-03: 730, 58%

Student Certificate Completion

Table 5. Student Certificate Completion Number

2011-12	572
Five-Year Average	355
Institutional Standard Recommendation	325
