Dear PaRC Members,

Please find attached:

- A. Enrollment and course success information from departments that requested a faculty position in 2015-16
- B. Summary information using example metrics for the instructional faculty prioritization

The ranking is based on program review information and discussions in spring and summer with the previous Vice Presidents of Instruction and the instructional deans. In addition, I held two sessions with the instructional deans to review the list in September 2016.

Based on discussions with the District, the current assumption is that we will be allowed to replace the 14 vacant instructional faculty positions in 2016-17. The attached proposal would rehire in the same department for 13 of the 14 positions.

I have provided a number of metrics for discussion and future consideration by PRC, IPB, and / or PaRC. These metrics are meant as examples that can be discussed by college community in greater detail this year.
