Well, here's another (more recent news) metric: return on investment! The Washington Post wrote about <u>Georgetown University Center on Education and the Workforce</u> (CEW)'s report which ranks Foothill #1 among California colleges that primarily award Associate Degrees (public and private) in terms of return on investment. Nationwide, we're 25th out of 1043 such institutions on ROI; 6th out of 718 such public institutions.

Speaking of resources, our Foothill teams surely deserve an "A+" for their efforts to bring in more resources to support student needs.

- Family Engagement Institute with **Betsy Nikolchev** applied and received a state grant to provide legal services to undocumented students.
- Veterans Resources team, thanks to help from our Foundation's Development Director Leigh Howell & the Los Altos Rotary, received a \$25,000 grant from SAGA.
- Psychological Services department with Prof. Lisa Slede's leadership received a grant that most likely will be \$250,000.

And then there are the amazing colleagues who are exemplifying service to our students -- beyond the call of duty! Have you ordered the delicious homemade tamales this year from Organizacion Latino Americano (O.L.A.) to support student
