

Despite a slight decrease in faculty, the program has become more efficient, handling increased demand with fewer resources. The rise in sections, student engagement, and productivity shows a strong demand for Honors courses and successful expansion.

Narrative: The Honors Program has seen steady growth in FTES, sections, and productivity. To keep this going, it needs to offer more courses, especially in STEM, recruit more faculty, secure resources, and build a stronger community, all while ensuring ongoing support and funding for future growth. Data: Overall, while Asian and Latinx students continue to make up the majority of the Honors Program, there has been some shifting in demographic percentages, with a slight increase in diversity, especially among Latinx



and Filipinx students. The number of Black students has dropped, with a decrease seen in 2023-24.

Narrative: Overall, the focus is on building stronger connections, enhancing program accessibility, and providing targeted resources for underrepresented students. Collaborating between the Honors program + Umoja, EOPS, and Puente is a great idea! It is a positive idea to collaborate with other learning communities, but we know that the capacity of these programs is limited. In this regard, honors programs are encouraged to reflect on specific ways in which they may support underserved students in their programs.

Feedback

Data: The program is performing well, with increasing success and retention rates, but targeted interventions are necessary to ensure continued success and reduce gaps in achievement for underrepresented groups.

Target outreach and support for Black, Latinx, and Filipinx students to improve retention and success. Monitor success by course modality (in-person, online, hybrid) to identify areas needing support. Increase student engagement to reduce withdrawals through counseling, mentoring, or workshops.

Narrative: The Honors Program has high success rates, with 92% for all students and 83% for underrepresented groups in 2023-24, outperforming non-Honors students. The goal is to maintain these success rates, especially for underrepresented students, and ensure Honors students continue to excel. To achieve this, more funding is needed for outreach events and partnerships with Umoja, Puente, EOPS, and the BIPOC center to strengthen student support.
