The drop from 64 to 30 completions in Math between 2022-23 and 2023-24 is notable.

The completion rates for transfer-level English and Math have improved, with the most significant increases seen in the past two academic years.

The program's commitment to aligning with Umoja practices and providing support is great. This multi-layered approach clearly prioritizes student's success and fosters a strong sense of belonging.

As readers, it is hard to interpret the raw numbers it may be helpful to see percentages of the students that pass. Perhaps this can give us a clearer picture of the data in the narrative more concisely.

Although counselor meetings have gone up, they still leave room for improvement, as 26% of students didn't meet the 6+ sessions goal in 2023-24.

The program is taking thoughtful steps to ensure student engagement and team-building a sense of belonging through more participation-driven strategies and feedback-informed improvements. Organizing events that build a sense of community and belonging with the BIPOC center is a great idea! With special attention being

given to providing opportunities throughout the year, this may be a great foundation for consistently increasing student engagement.

The data provides a mix of things, with growth in some areas (enrollment, productivity) but challenges in others (unduplicated headcount). It suggests the need for ongoing adjustments to balance recruitment,

retention, and course offerings. We appreciate the Umoja team trying new approaches i.e., combined math section with Puente. Though the joint approach was too challenging to sustain, it was good information to learn. Please continue to be innovative and think differently about how to best support scholars.

36% increase in productivity, showing significant improvement. Meeting Program Goals: Productivity has remained above 450 for the last two academic years, which aligns with program objectives.

Male students outnumber female students, with the percentage of male enrollment at 75% in 2022-23 before slightly decreasing to 68% in 2023-24. Female enrollment declined from a high of 45% in 2020-21 to 25% in 2022-23 but rebounded slightly to 32% in 2023-24.

We see that Umoja has traditionally focused on recruiting male athletes, contributing to the gender imbalance.

Your narrative aligns well with the given data. How can we advocate for more accurate reporting of multi-ethnic identities to ensure Black/Latinx students are recognized in both categories rather than being counted solely as Latinx?

We see that the success rates have improved significantly, rising from 78% in 2019-20 to 93% in 2022-23 and 2023-24. Non-success and withdrawal rates have gone down, suggesting stronger academic performance and retention among Umoja students.

The Umoja program progressed in supporting student success, exceeding college-wide performance for Black, Latinx, and Filipinx students, which is a notable accomplishment. However, issues with how students are categorized in institutional data could impact visibility and targeted support. How does the group intend to address this critical data challenge?
