6. SB235 meeting in Sacramento- Harry Adams, Political Director of SEIU, has offered the following language that will amend SB235 and preserve Classified Senates in our district and others.

Proposed wording:

The people of the state of California do enact as follows:
Section 1. Section 70901.2 is added to the Education code:
70901.2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, when a
classified staff representative is to serve on a college or district task
force, committee, or other governance group, the selection of that
classified staff representative shall be made by the exclusive
representative of the classified employees of that college or district.

Nothing in this law shall preclude other representation agreements
made through collective bargaining unit. The board of governors
to determine a process for the selection of a classified staff
representative in a situation where no exclusive representative exists.

- **b.** Modified Plum Proposal- commencement. What has been proposed is that final exams are given up for commencement day. All students are off the campus by 1:00 Nobody would be compelled to be at the college. Maybe there will be a better attendance for commencement.
- c. Foothill/DeAnza Senate Childcare Fund: Senate did not think this would work for Foothill College. Possible selections for a childcare stipend. Have the FA ask management to reduce the childcare amount for District employees. We need to do some research to find out How many people need financial help?, Who needs what? What is the sliding scale? Call Kathleen Benson and other childcare centers and find out what they charge.
- **d. Curriculum Committee** who will be replacing Shirley Barker, Curriculum Co-Chair while on sabatical? The Senate decided to appt. a

one year interium chair in Shirley Barker's absence and reopen the position in 2002/03.
