

General Education Credit for IGETC and/or CSU-Breadth-Approved Transfer Courses

Whereas each year hundreds of students transfer to Foothill College from other California colleges and universities, many having completed coursework that has been previously been approved for IGETC and/or CSU-Breadth general education credit;

Whereas UC and CSU faculty rigorously review courses before approving them for IGETC and/or CSU-Breadth credit, thus obviating the need for Foothill College faculty to reevaluate these courses;

Whereas there is substantial overlap between inclusion criteria and learning outcomes of the IGETC, CSU-Breadth, and Foothill College general education areas;

Resolved, that the Foothill College Curriculum Committee facilitate student transfer by adopting the general education articulation patterns outlined below:
