- New Department Code: The Biological and Health Sciences division has approved changing the department code for Paramedic Program courses, from EMTP to PARA. The new code of PARA will go into effect for the 2017-18 catalog.
- Stand Alone Course Approvals: The state Chancellor's Office recently announced a change to the approval process for Stand Alone courses. Although final approval of Stand Alone has occurred at the state level for the past few years, the state is transferring that authority back to the colleges, so approval will now occur at the local level. CCC agreed that we may continue to use our current Stand Alone form without any need for modification, and that the change will be in the approval process itself. Stand Alone courses will be reviewed by CCC, with a first and second read prior to taking action. If you have any questions about this change in process, please contact your CCC Reps.
